• **Producer:** I. Savvoglou – P. Tsivolas • **Name:** Rodon

• Origin: Phragma, Sardes and Plaka areas

• Category: ORGANIC VARIETAL WINE • Type: R

Muscat of Alexandria and Limnio,.

• Type: Rosé semi-dry



**VARIETY:** Muscat of Alexandria and Limnio. Harvested first ten days of September.



**SOIL:** Volcanic, medium texture (poor in calcium).



**VINEYARD:** Vineyards from Phragma, Sardes and Plaka areas of Limnos, with a yield of about 800 kg per hectare for Muscat of Alexandria and 600 kg per hectare for Limnio.



MICROCLIMATE: Low rainfall, strong winds, relatively low temperatures in winter and hot and dry summers.



**WINEMAKING:** The two varieties are combined, after static desalination, at a controlled temperature of 16 - 17 °C.



**ORGANIC CHARACTERISTICS:** Intense rose color, aromas of rose and strawberry, pleasant and cool taste, with a good aftertaste.



**GASTRONOMY:** Served at 10-12°C and accompanied by fruits, cheese, sweets and nuts
